Shri Arup Chanda is a former bureau chief and editor, senior journalist, political commentator and writer. Equipped with a graduate degree from St. Xavier's College affiliated to the University of Calcutta, Arup has over 36 years of experience working in leading English newspapers, television news channels, international wire agencies, and news portals across the country. Arup has worked with The New Indian Express as Bureau Chief for West Bengal and North East; with NewsX television channel as Bureau Chief; The Tribune posted in Chennai to cover Tamil Nadu and Sri Lanka; reported from the India-Pakistan border while he was with the Indo-Asian News Service posted in Chandigarh; covered stories from Bangladesh as Bureau Chief for news and current affairs in Television International news channel; has worked as a political and business correspondent for The Economic Times in Kolkata, and has also worked with The Statesman, and The Telegraph as a correspondent and covered West Bengal and the entire north east region of the country. Arup has also worked for the Reuters, Agence France Press, Deutsche Welle-German Radio, and China's news agency Xinhua in senior positions.

Arup has covered eight Lok Sabha elections in India since 1984 and the last one being in 2014 other than Assembly elections in West Bengal, Assam, Haryana, Punjab, and Tamil Nadu. Arup has also covered insurgency in Punjab, Assam and in the north eastern states. Arup was invited by the Government of the USA under the prestigious International Visitors' Programme in 1991 and extensively toured all over the country.
