KUAA INITIATIVES

4.1 Alumni Portal

Karnavati University has a dedicated portal for alumni where they register themselves and avail plethora of opportunities. Alumni can connect with one another, their juniors, seniors, batch mates, faculty members. The portal has a number of features as mentioned below:

4.1.1 Alumni Directory

4.3.1 Karnavati School of Dentistry

4.3.1.1 "It's time to smile again with Implant Dentistry... Let's Start to Finish.."



Dr. Mayur Parmar conducted the session on "It's time to smile again with Implant Dentistry... Let's Start to Finish.." He spoke about basic cases for under graduates as well as advanced cases for post graduates. He shared his marvelous journey with all of us. He shared cases that dental UGs usually don't encounter, like full mouth rehabilitation using all-on-four technique, direct and indirect sinus lift and many more. The upcoming doctors witnessed the power of smile designing and how it can change someone's life.

Dr. Mayur Parmar is an eminent Periodontist and Gold Medalist. He completed his post graduation in Periodontology from Karnavati School of Dentistry. He has been honored with a Fellowship award from Indian Society of Oral Implantology. He has various publications in national and international journals and has given lectures on implantology and periodontal plastic surgery on various platforms. He is presently working as Associate Professor in Goenka Research Institute of Dental Science and Owner of Dental Square Clinic in Gandhinagar.



4.3.1.2 "Magnification in Dentistry-Is it really necessary?" by Dr. Jay Kothari



Dr. Jay Kothari is a MicroEndodontist practicing in Ahmedabad. He did his undergraduation from Karnavati School of Dentistry. He did his MDS in Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics from Gujarat University. He additionally pursued his Fellowship in Microdentistry from Dept. of Microdentistry at Govt. Dental College and Hospital, Mumbai. Currently he is pursuing his Ph.D. from Gujarat University. He has special interest in Microscope based Endodontics and General Dentistry.

Dr. Jay Kothari conducted the session on "Magnification in Dentistry-Is it really necessary?"

Dr. Kothari gave insights on magnification; its importance and various tools used for the same. He showed how magnifying loupes can be used on a daily basis in dentistry. He also busted myths related to magnification. He shared his few cases and how one can get the best magnification tool, as per one's requirements. More than 250 upcoming doctors attended the session.









4.3.1.3 "To be or not to be an oral pathologist" by Dr. Stuti Bajaj

Dr. Stuti Bajaj conducted the session on "To be or not to be an oral pathologist"

Dr. Bajaj gave insights on the world of oral pathology wherein she shared various career options one can pursue after Master's in Oral Pathology. She also shared the use of some oral pathology procedures that are useful in clinical practice, like biopsies, and shared the importance of oral pathology. More than 230 upcoming doctors attended the session.







Dr. Stuti Bajaj is an oral Pathologist. She did her BDS and MDS from Karnavati School of Dentistry. She also did a fellowship in aesthetic medicine and Facial Cosmetology from Germany.

She is practicing at her private clinic Face Multispecialty Dental and Cosmetology Hospital Ahmedabad. She has also done MBA in Healthcare and Hospital.

She is associated with different NGOs and has been awarded for her excellence in studies as well as sports. She is also a mentor at different platforms.







4.3.1.4 Interaction Session on 'My DDS Journey' by Dr. Juhi Shah

Karnavati University Alumni Association in collaboration with Karnavati School of Dentistry organized an Interaction Session with Dr. Juhi Shah (DDS) where she gave insights about her DDS journey. Dr. Shah shared her journey of starting as a BDS student at KSD to being DDS candidate at Columbia University College of Dental Medicine. She gave insights on how and when to start preparing for studying in foreign universities, what challenges she faced and how to overcome those challenges. She emphasized turning challenges to opportunities.

Dr. Juhi Shah graduated in 2015 with BDS from Karnavati School of Dentistry. Thereafter, she worked as Dentist at Cure Smile Dental Care, Ahmedabad till 2019. She has a rich working experience in the USA. She was a DDS candidate at Columbia University College of Dental Medicine. Dr. Shah has been actively involved with the community services too.





4.3.2 Unitedworld School of Law

4.3.2.1 "Corporate Governance: Development, Global Perspective and Opportunities for Convergence" by Ms. Grishma Brahmbhatt



Ms. Grishma Brahmbhatt conducted a session on Corporate Governance: Development, Global Perspective and Opportunities for Convergence. Ms. Grishma is a leading expert on corporate law with a Master's degree from the University of Law, London. He gave insights on the types of offences considered under the law, stages and types of evidence, different sections, chargesheet etc.



Under this campaign, alumni profiles are featured on a regular basis on our social media platforms, namely, Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and Alumni Portal.







7.3 Synchro Event: UWSL Freshers' Orientation




